

Purifan Free Classroom Trial Sign-up Form

The Purifan Free Classroom Trial Program allows you to sign-up to test Purifans for as many as **10 classrooms, and 20 Purifans**. After a 30 day free trial period you can choose to pay for or return the Purifans. This is a no-obligation FREE TRIAL to help your school system to evaluate the many benefits of filtering the classroom air. **Purifan is only offering a limited number of free school trials.** The basic rules to the program are:

- **Install the Purifans** - Must be willing to work with Purifan to install and operate the Purifans on acceptable ceiling fan motors, or new ceiling fan motors that will be supplied at no charge from Purifan. If new ceiling fan electrical work is required, the school must provide this electrical wiring work at their cost. If a school wants to return the Purifans we will provide return instructions.
- **Complete Short Survey** - Must be willing to fill out a short teacher survey on the benefits perceived during the test period. Questions relate to allergies, health, attendance, comfort issues and student and teacher performance.
- **Purchase or Return the Fans** – At the end of the trial period, you either purchase or return the Purifans and any motors supplied for the test. Must be willing to keep the boxes during the trial period. If you choose to return the Purifans, you can re-install the fan blades on your own ceiling fans to have standard ceiling fans in the rooms. Purifan will pay to return the Purifans and motors via ground freight, or our local dealer will pick up the returned units.
- **Choose the Right Classroom** – Purifans should be installed in classrooms where the teacher has allergy issues, or has students with allergy or Asthma issues. The classroom should be one where the same students spend the majority of their school time in the same classroom. Younger pre-K-5 students are most at risk and should be considered first.
- **Operate the Purifans Correctly** – Run the Purifans on high, counter-clockwise rotation 24 hours a day. Keep the classroom windows and door closed as much as possible for maximum benefit.
- **Allow Particle Count Testing** – Give Purifan permission to measure particle counts in the Purifan classrooms and adjoining classrooms during class hours to measure the comparative particle count levels. This is performed quietly with minimal classroom disruption. Any testing costs will be paid for by Purifan. These tests will measure the particle counts in classrooms to compare before and after results.

Eight Easy Steps To Set-up a Free School Trial

Many School Administrators, Board Members, Principals and Superintendents are interested in evaluating Purifans in some of their Classrooms. Once the decision is made, the simple one page form should be filled out, and faxed in to 316-262-0758. If there are multiple buildings involved, we should get the name of the Principals in each building. We can work with the Principals to select classrooms where a teacher or student has serious allergy or Asthma issues. By delegating this project to the Principals we can usually proceed quickly to schedule and complete the installation.

1. The person with the final authority should make the decision to do a trial of 4 to 10 classrooms. This is a NO COST FREE TRIAL, so there is nothing to lose.
2. Fill out the form above and fax it to Purifan at 316-262-0758.
3. Send any additional contact information including any principal's names, phone number and email addresses, for any buildings being considered in the trial. Include the facility manager's contact information.
4. We contact the Principals to select the best classrooms based on teacher's health issues and other considerations.
5. We ship or deliver the Purifans to the school facility.
6. We arrive to install the Purifans in the classrooms.
7. Your teachers evaluate the Purifans over a 30 day period. We provide a training memo instructing them on "What changes to watch for in student health areas." We can also do before and after particle levels, or compare equipped classrooms to non-equipped classrooms to show the particle reductions achieved.
8. You decide to keep or return the Purifans base on your own evaluation of the benefits.

Most schools can see the potential payback in health costs for teachers and students. Most schools have limited funds and just install Purifans in classrooms where teachers are spending a lot on allergy/Asthma medications, or missing a lot of sick days. Purifan will also work with schools to promote this project to PTA groups or help with grant-writing to find funding from a variety of government and charitable sources. In Attendance Based Funding states the payback can include increased daily attendance, which drives state funding.

Leasing Purifans is also an option to allow savings and increased funding to pay for the Purifans over a 3 to 5 year leasing program. The program is a lease to own program with annual escape provisions incase funding is not available. The lease finishes with a \$1 buyout, and includes filter service in the lease payments. The payback can be 25 to 1 for some schools, making the leasing commitment pay off in many other expense areas. Families may also be willing to pay a fee, do fundraising or tap their employers since fewer sick days can be worth a lot of money to families, their insurance companies and their employers.
